Prospective students should become familiar with department faculty and their areas of interest. The best way to do this is to read the CVs on our Department Faculty Page . You should discuss your specific research interests with multiple faculty members as you work on your application.				
Student fit with the doctoral program is an important element of the admissions process and applicants should demonstrate their ability to answer the following questions:				
 Why do you seek a research-based doctoral degree in the social sciences? What type of career do you plan to pursue with this degree? What appropriate academic experience and preparation do you have for required doctoral-level courses? How familiar are you with the curriculum of the YDFS degree and how do you think the curriculum will contribute to your professional goals and employment? Can you demonstrate an understanding of faculty research interests and the correspondence between your interests and those of multiple faculty members in FYCS? 				
MAKE NOTE OF THE APPLICATION DEADLINE The deadline for your application and related materials is January 15. Note that in order to meet the application deadline, your complete application and all supporting documents must be received by the due date.
